MAIN SERVICES

NAI SUBAH



This program strives to address key issues faced by people living with HIV and AIDS through their state level networks and various other stakeholders presently initiated in the states of Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Jharkhand, Manipur, Mizoram, Nagaland, Delhi, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Meghalaya and Rajasthan.

LOK KALYAN YOJANA



The program focuses on the urban poor, presently engaging in 136 slum areas in Nagpur, on issues related to healthcare, education, livelihood, hygiene and substance abuse.



JAN VIKAS KENDRA

The program addresses key issues faced by migrant labourers and villagers affected by industrial distress and displacement. Presently the programs are active in Tembhari and Totladoh areas, in Maharashtra.

VOLUNTARY COALITION FOR LABOUR CONCERNS



The Vidarbha Coalition for Labour Concerns focusses on strengthening governance structures in the rural areas such as Panchayati Raj and Gram Sabha, by engaging citizens on their constitutional rights, helping them access various government schemes and thereby address social justice and labour rights issues in 11 districts of Maharashtra and seven other states in India.



RELIEF AND RECONSTRUCTION

CSA engages in relief and reconstruction, responding to various emergency needs. The Nagpur floods and Manipur emergencies have been some of the relief efforts, reaching out to more than 10,000 people affected with essential food supplies, hygiene, medicines and household items.

WALKING WITH THE MARGINALIZED



The program engages various stakeholders to connect with the marginalized, particularly those discriminated due to the gender and sexual identities, helping them access sustainable livelihood options and essential needs.
